Swami Bhoomananda Tirtha, the guide and inspiration for the FRNV, said that the chairman and managing director of HLL Lifecare Ltd, Thiruvananthapuram, would be the convenor-director of the state chapter of the FRNV. He said that dignitaries and functionaries from different parts of the country and the Gulf would attend the function.

The participants include FRNV president E Sreedharan

(MD, Delhi Metro), general secretary Bharat Wakhlu (Resident Director, Tata Group), vice-president Ramesh Ramakrishnan (Chairman, Transworld Group) and vice-president Anand Krishnan (COO, Dubai International Capital).
